SUBJECT: Request for Reward Cancellation

RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Edmonton Police Commission (EPC) approve the following recommendation:

1. It is recommended that a reward in the amount of \$40,000.00 for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of *Lillian BERUBE*, be cancelled.

BACKGROUND/COMMENTS:

This report will provide information and present recommendations for action by the EPC in regards to:

- a) a monetary reward of \$40,000.00 is posted in the homicide of *Lillian BERUBE*, who was murdered on 1987 October 27-28. The latest reward was granted by the EPC on 2008 October 16 for a three year period and has been posted since 1987 December 4. This reward should now be cancelled as *Charles William ABOU* was charged with her murder on 2009 November 3. The accused was identified by police investigative means and no person has provided a tip which would meet the eligibility of seeking this reward. The Edmonton Police Service file is #87-131509.

COMMENTS:

This is a solved homicide investigation, with no further need to have a reward posted.

CONCLUSION:

It is requested that the preceding recommendation be adopted by the Edmonton Police Commission.
