Objective: Throughout his career, Bill Bratton has insisted that “Cops Count—Police Matter.” And this has never been more true than it is today! The former Commissioner of NYPD and Chief of LAPD—and now Altegrity Risk International Chairman—will discuss the importance of creating secure communities as a foundation for secure nations and the critical “front line” role that law enforcement plays in this process.

Mr. Bratton has demonstrated through his actions and frequently cited the importance of forging a new optimistic consensus that in a democracy, law enforcement at all levels—from national government to local police departments—must accept responsibility for crime, fear, and disorder and do everything in their power to ensure safety and civility. During his remarks, he will provide examples of how this can be accomplished, as well as discuss how he used CompStat, the internationally acclaimed command accountability system he put in place while serving in New York City, to revolutionize policing and prevent crime.

Based on experiences from his current work as leader of a major international security solutions company, Mr. Bratton will also share his thoughts about why policing and rule of law fundamentals must be a central element of any realistic plan to assist troubled nations and emerging democracies. He believes this is the critical path to furthering the goals of international security, combating terrorism, and improving overall security in our communities—Homeland Security is Community Security.
