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This report has been prepared for the May 16, 2013, Edmonton Police Commission meeting.

During the month of April 2013, Professional Standards Branch opened 71 new files:

- 11 Public complaints as defined by Part 5 of the *Police Act*;
- 1 Internal complaint as defined by Part 5 of the *Police Act*;
- 8 EPS Matters; and
- 51 Citizen Contacts.

Additionally, 0 files were directed for criminal investigation (Statutory Complaint).

Concluded 98 files:

- 1 Public Statutory Complaint;
- 0 Internal Statutory Complaints;
- 15 Public complaints as defined by Part 5 of the *Police Act*, including 3 complaints regarding policies or services provided by the EPS;
- 6 Internal complaints as defined by Part 5 of the *Police Act*;
- 13 EPS Matters; and
- 63 Citizen Contacts.

The Edmonton Police Service received 37,883 calls in Communications Section, dispatched 12,373 of those calls and recorded opening 22 compliments.

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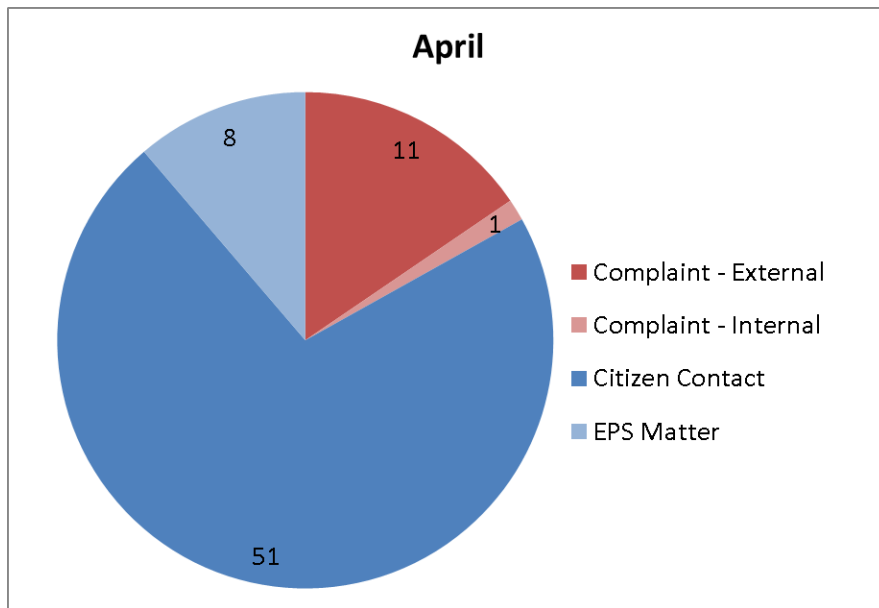

**STATISTICAL SUMMARY**

**April Update**

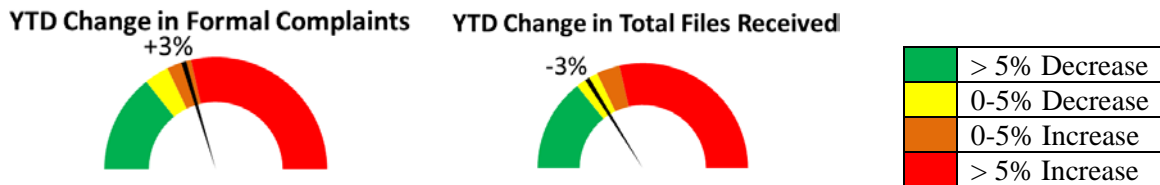
**1. RECEIVED FILES**

The following figure shows the number and type of files received during the month of April. Blue colours represent informal files and red colours represent formal investigations. Lighter shades indicate internally generated files and darker shades indicate externally generated files. As can be seen below, during the month of April, PSB received 59 informal files and 12 formal complaints.

The following figure shows the year-to-date percentage increase or decrease in formal complaints and total files compared to 2012 values. The difference in formal complaints represents an increase of 2 investigations, and the difference in total files received represents a decrease of 10 files.

## 2. CURRENT WORKLOAD

The following figure displays the status of all open PSB files. As of April 30, 2013, PSB had 316 open investigations; 242 of those files are *Police Act* or statutory investigations. The remaining files are informal concerns received internally or from the public. An investigation is listed as “Suspended” when it is not currently being advanced. Reasons for suspending a file may include executive review of the investigation, disciplinary hearings, criminal investigation, or court proceedings. An investigation is listed as “Forwarded” when it is ongoing but not under the control of PSB. Reasons for forwarding a file may include supervisory reviews, obtaining legal opinions, or investigation by outside investigators.

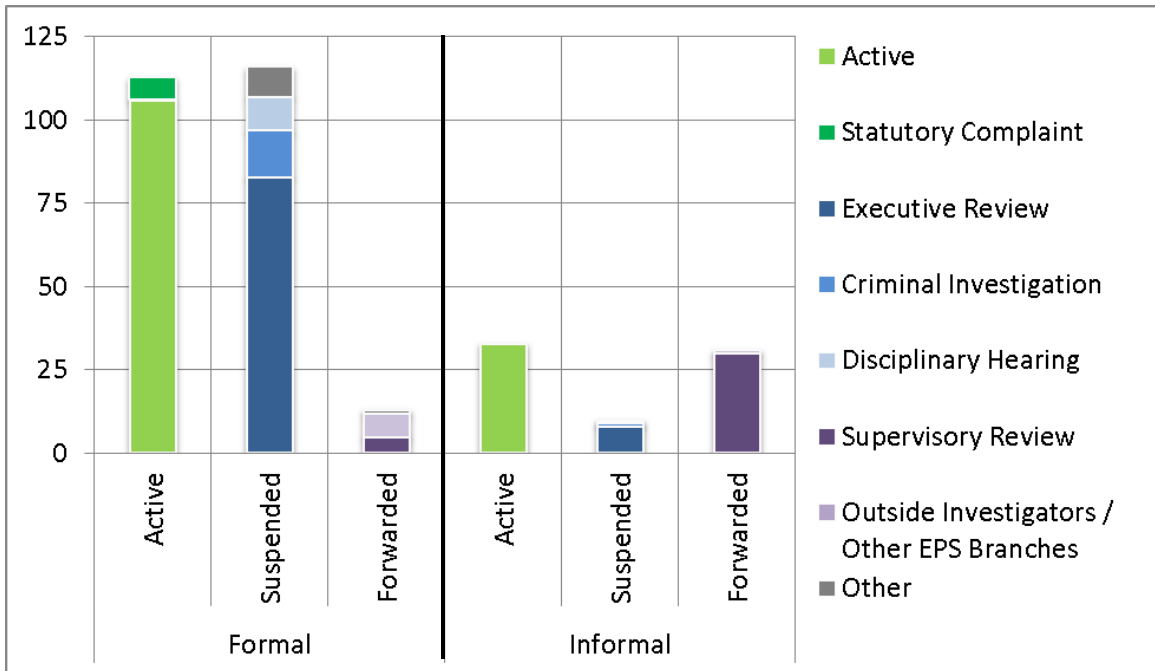


Figure 2-1. Status of All Open Investigations and Reasons for Suspension or Forward

The following figure shows the age and status of all open PSB investigations. Each individual marker (i.e., diamond, circle or triangle) represents one investigation; thus the number of open investigations from a given time period is indicated by the density of the markers.

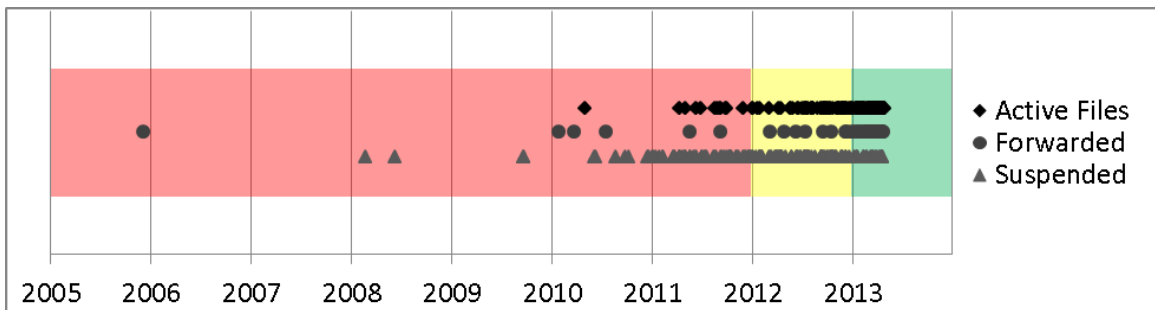


Figure 2-2. Age and Status of All Open Investigations

The following figure shows the stage of investigation for formal complaints by month. The stages of investigation include Clarification (interviewing the complainant to determine the specific details of the complaint), Collection (collection of evidence and witness interviews), Subject Officer Interviews (explanatory reports and/or interview of the subject officer), Report (compiling the final report) and Executive Review. Investigations may also be placed on “Hold” (e.g., for dispute resolution, legal review, hearing, etc.) or may be undetermined (e.g., for complaints that are not proceeding to formal investigation). Complaints in the “Hold” stage or with an undetermined stage are not included in this figure.

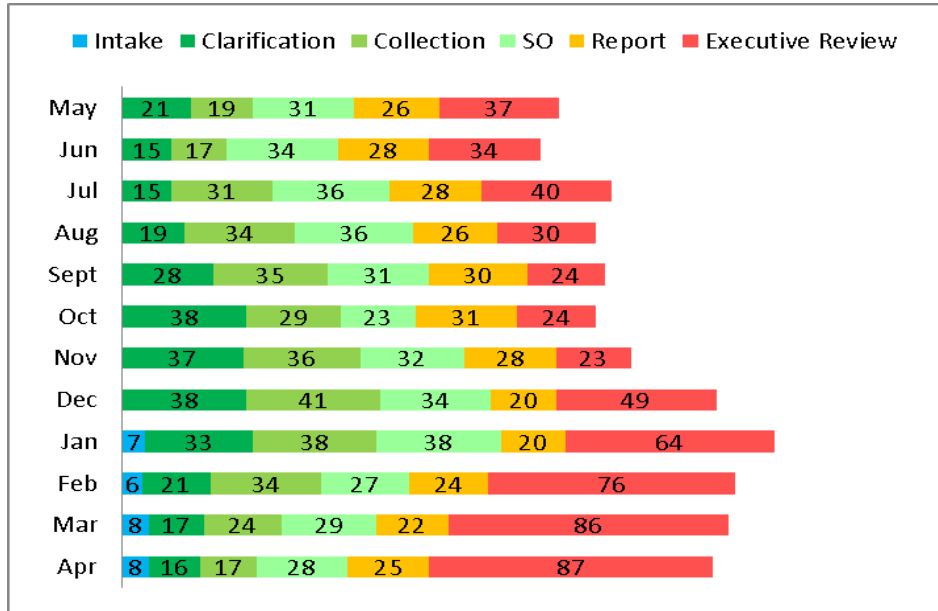


Figure 2-3. Monthly Comparison of Complaint Stages

The following figure breaks down the 87 files marked above as being in the Executive Review stage. As seen below, 15 of the files are less than 6 months old, 41 files are currently being reviewed by an investigative manager and 40 are being reviewed by the Inspector. The remaining 6 files (“Other” category) may already be concluded or are awaiting review outside of PSB (e.g., by the Commission or the Chief).

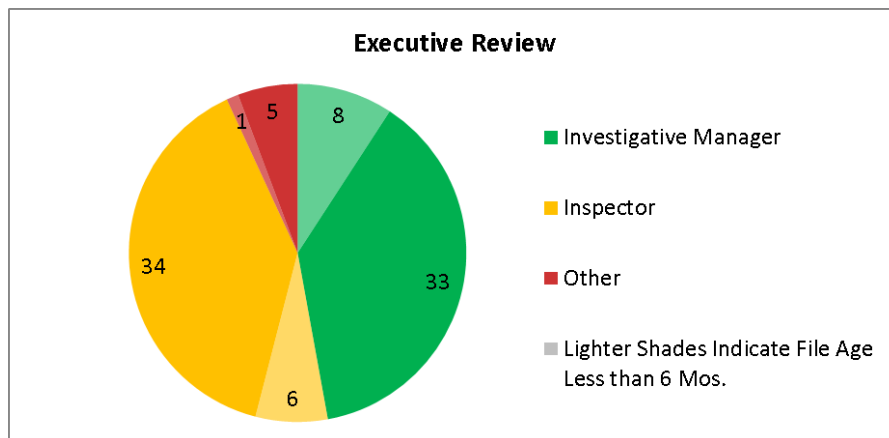


Figure 2-4. Assignment of Files in Executive Review Stage

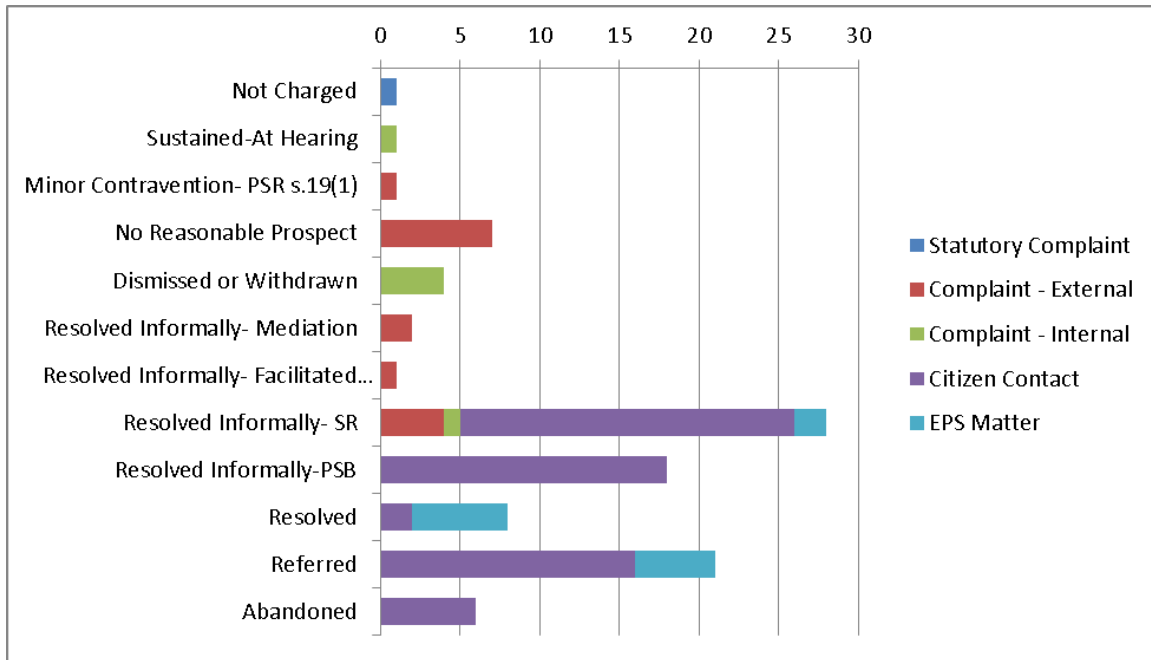


Figure 3-1. Dispositions of Concluded Files

In conclusion I would just like you that the aid all these people provided was greatly appreciated and my thanks and that of the [deleted] family goes out to them on what they attempted to do.

I would like to take this opportunity to compliment your Officer, Constable Khurana, Badge 3303 for helping myself and my two daughters out today.

Constable Khurana had accompanied my eldest daughter, [deleted] to my home today after intervening in an assault. I live with my other daughter, [deleted] and the two have serious issues between them. Unfortunately, when your officer and [deleted] showed up on my doorstep today, the family tension gave way to bad behavior and unnecessary harsh words between the two siblings.

This has caused me a great deal of stress and angst as I have sought to keep the peace and help both of them—an impossible feat let me assure you! The girls were very vulgar to each other and towards myself.

Constable Khurana intervened on my behalf in a very powerful way that resulted in a positive outcome between myself and my two girls. Constable Khurana may have started out his day by

rescuing [deleted] but I see it as an inadvertent rescue of me—something I have desperately needed for a long time.

Sometimes it takes a third party to reflect back to those who are behaving badly just how much their negative actions are affecting those who care about them the most. He provided a skillful mirror back to my girls in a firm, rational manner—a big reality check!—that helped to restore our relationships.

There have been some heartfelt apologies since this episode, I am happy to report, and I am hopeful that we can all start to heal now that responsibility has been taken by both girls for their sorry behavior.

I never thought that a police officer could affect such change on a more intrinsic level and am very impressed by the excellent people care demonstrated by your staff member. Whatever you are teaching these young men please, keep doing it—it is working!

Constable Khurana did you proud today and my own private world is now a much safer place thanks to this amazing young man.
