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This report has been prepared for the May 17, 2012, Edmonton Police Commission meeting.

During the month of April 2012, Professional Standards Branch opened 97 new files:

- 12 Public complaints as defined by Part 5 of the *Police Act*;
- 7 Internal complaints as defined by Part 5 of the *Police Act*;
- 9 EPS Matters; and
- 69 Citizen Contacts.

Additionally, 1 file was directed for Criminal Investigation (*Statutory Complaints*).

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## APRIL 2012 OVERVIEW & UPDATES

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For the month of April Professional Standards Branch underwent changes in its Administrative and Intake Section staffing. A long time administrative assistant has gone on temporary leave until the end of October 2012 to another law enforcement unit for career development purposes. Management took this opportunity to restructure duties and responsibilities of existing administrative staff so that tasks were streamlined to the flow of PSB investigations and more suited to the individual. This departure has left a vacant position that will be temporarily filled until it can once again be permanently occupied.

Intake Section has also posted a position for a new PSB Constable; the current Intake PSB Constable will be advanced to an Acting Detective position in support of their application into the promotion process. The management team is very excited to assist the constable in their career development.

Professional Standards Branch has also made advances in the McNeil project. Police Information Check Section successfully queried all current EPS members to certify which members have a McNeil disclosure requirement. At present, PSB is auditing the results and creating a McNeil record and tracking system in IAPro that will correlate to the electronic disclosure system being developed in EPROS. In collaboration with our IT section, it is anticipated that the EPROS McNeil Court Disclosure System will be in the “testing” phase this July.

**File Overview – April 2012**

For this reason, the number of active Statutory Complaints is not represented in the sum total.

Suspended files represent files in which the investigation is not yet completed, but is “paused” (e.g., a file may be suspended pending Criminal Court or during the course of a Disciplinary Hearing).
