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This report has been prepared for the March 19, 2015, Edmonton Police Commission meeting.

During the month of February 2015, Professional Standards Branch opened 74 new files:

- 8 Public complaints as defined by Part 5 of the *Police Act*;
- 2 Internal complaints as defined by Part 5 of the *Police Act*;
- 8 EPS Matters; and
- 56 Citizen Contacts.

Additionally, 2 files were directed for Criminal Investigation (*Statutory Complaints*).

Concluded 203 files:

- 0 Public *Statutory* complaints;
- 2 Internal *Statutory* complaint;
- 16 Public complaints as defined by Part 5 of the *Police Act*, including 1 complaint regarding policies or services provided by the EPS;
- 6 Internal complaints as defined by Part 5 of the *Police Act*;
- 17 EPS Matter; and
- 162 Citizen Contacts.

The Edmonton Police Service received 34,310 calls in Communications Section, dispatched 11,356 of those calls and recorded opening 10 compliments.

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STATISTICAL SUMMARY

**February Update**

**1. RECEIVED FILES**

The following figure shows the number and type of files received during the month of February. Blue colours represent informal files and red colours represent formal investigations. Lighter shades indicate internally generated files and darker shades indicate externally generated files. As can be seen below, during the month of February 2015, PSB received 64 informal files and 10 formal complaints.

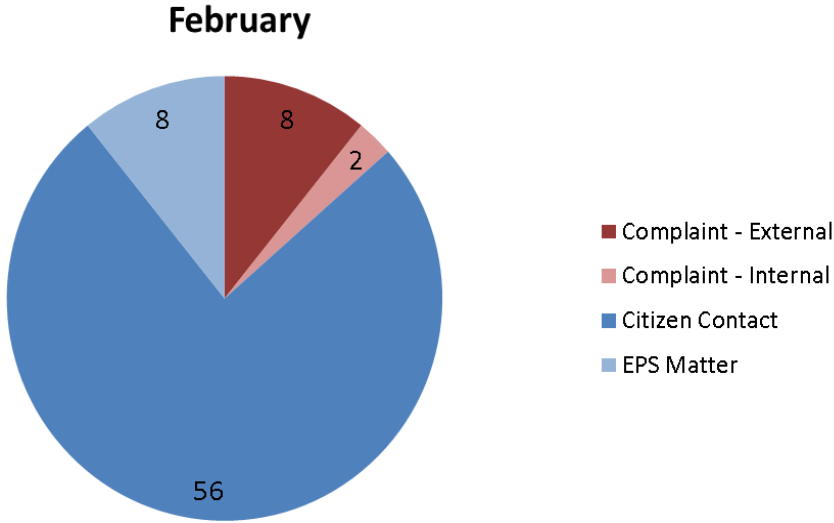


Figure 1-1. Type of Files Received During February

The following figure shows the yearly percentage increase or decrease in formal complaints and total files compared to 2014 values. YTD change in Formal Complaints represents a decrease of 18 complaints as compared to the same point in time in 2014. The YTD Total Files Received represents a decrease of 11 files as compared to the same point in time in 2014.

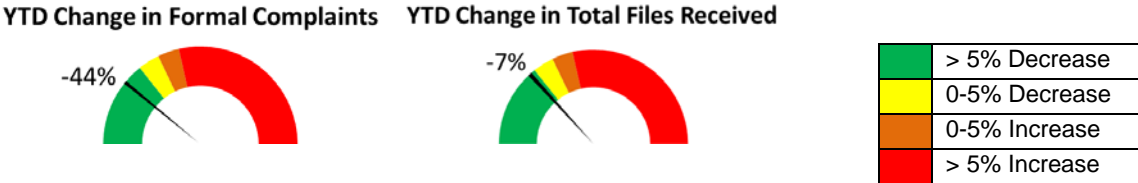


Figure 1-2. Yearly Changes in Files Received

## 2. CURRENT WORKLOAD

The following figure displays the status of all open PSB files. As of February 28, 2015, PSB had 406 open investigations; 260 of those files are *Police Act* or statutory investigations. The remaining files are informal concerns received internally or from the public. An investigation is listed as “Suspended” when it is not currently being advanced. Reasons for suspending a file may include executive review of the investigation, disciplinary hearings, criminal investigation, or court proceedings. An investigation is listed as “Forwarded” when it is ongoing but not under the control of PSB. Reasons for forwarding a file may include supervisory reviews, obtaining legal opinions, or investigation by outside investigators.

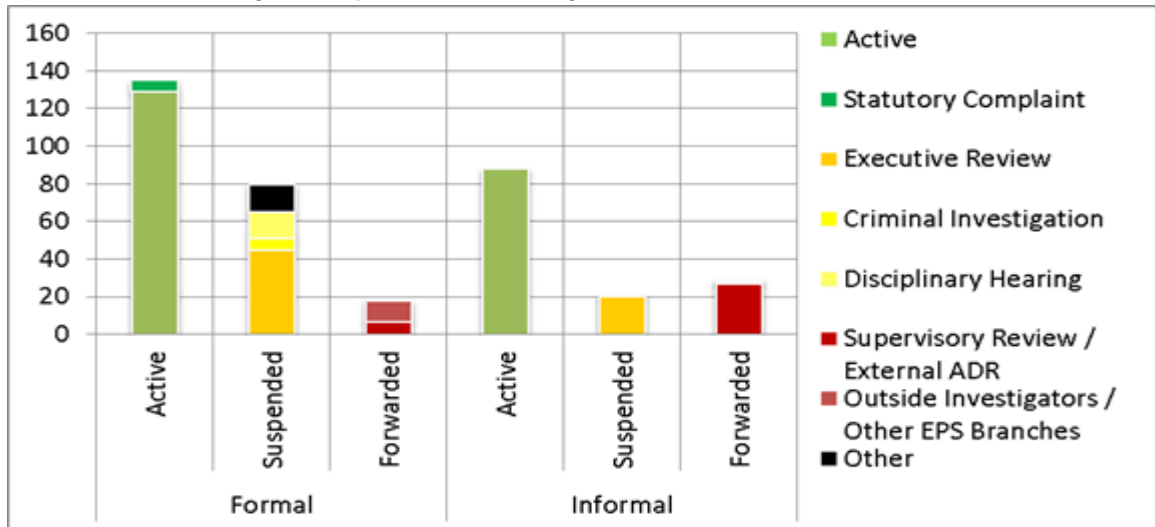


Figure 2-1. Status of All Open Investigations and Reasons for Suspension or Forward

The following figure shows the age and status of all open PSB investigations. As with the definitions for Figure 2-1 the following chart will show files that are listed as Active, Suspended, and Forwarded. This chart will break down these files by year, with markers showing the total number of files in each status for the corresponding year. (i.e. 2010 has a total of 4 open files, of those 3 files are Suspended and 1 is Forwarded)

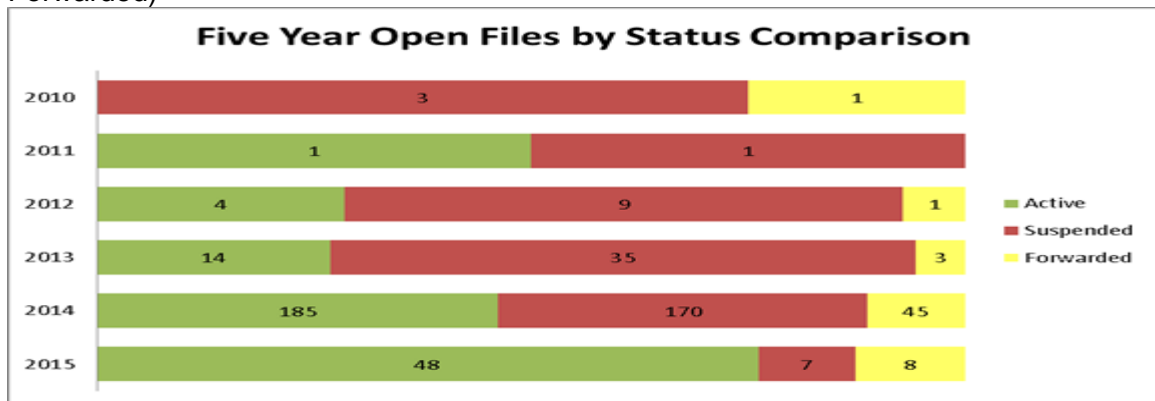


Figure 2-2. Age and Status of All Open Investigations

The following figure shows the stage of investigation for formal complaints by month. This is a representation of files that were in a particular stage within the month. **Meaning that a file would be counted twice if it moved through two stages within the month, this does not represent the current amount of files in each stage, but rather the fluid motion of the files as they progress.** Previously this chart was based solely on Priority coding through IAPro that included codes based on the importance of the file on a priority scale. This process has since been altered to show stages more accurately and help to eliminate human error, as such the Analyst manually changed each active file to show the proper stage in Priority coding, thus affecting the results shown in the chart below. The stages of investigation include:

- Clarification (interviewing the complainant to determine the specific details of the complaint);
- Collection (collection of evidence and witness interviews);
- Subject Officer Interviews (explanatory reports and/or interview of the subject officer);
- Report (compiling the final report);
- Investigative Review (review by the investigative manager);
- Executive Review (review by the Inspector, Chief, and final concluding processes).

Investigations may also be pending other processes (e.g., dispute resolution, legal review, hearing, etc.) or may be undetermined (e.g., for complaints that are not proceeding to formal investigation).

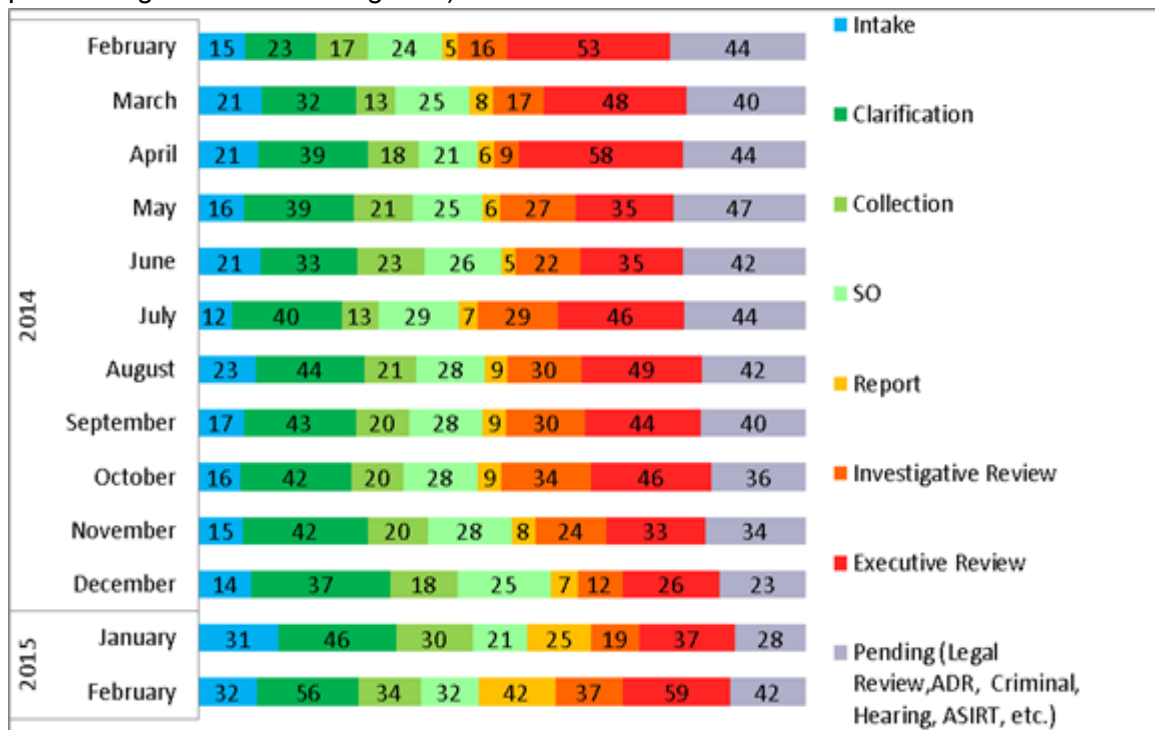


Figure 2-3. Monthly Comparison of Complaint Stages

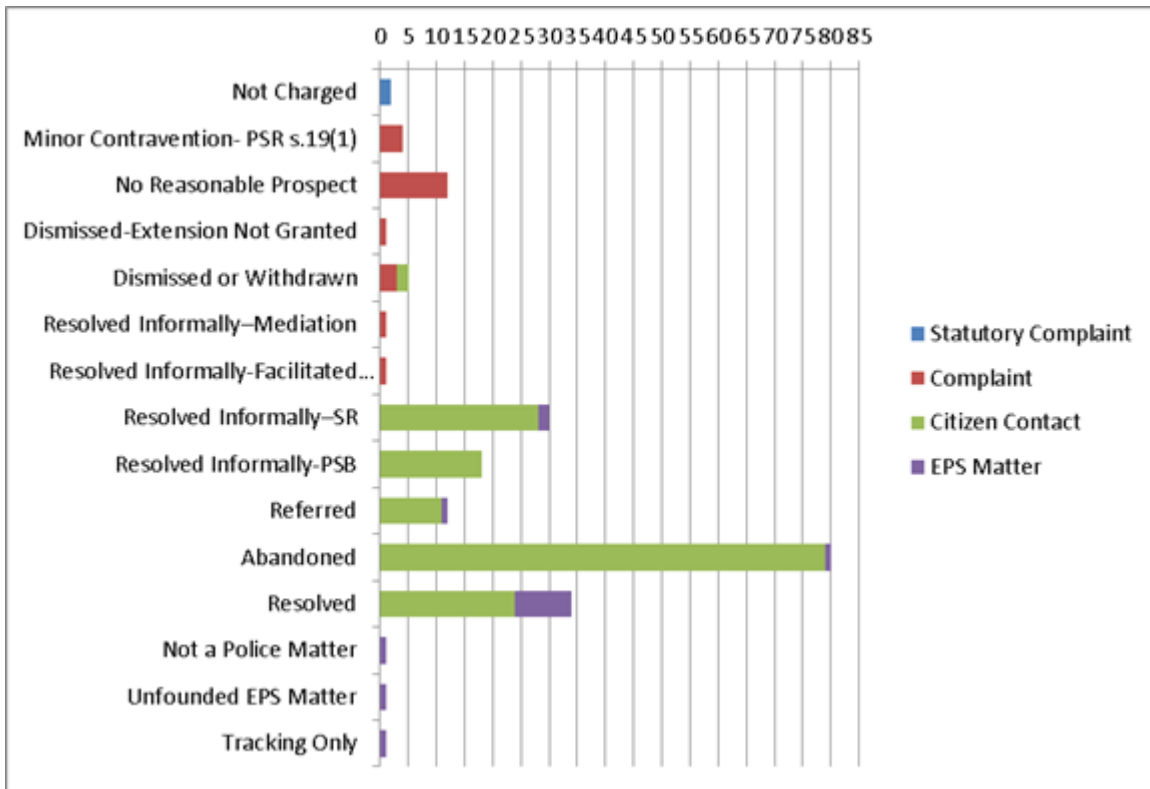


Figure 3-1. Dispositions of Concluded Files

**Summary**

PSB received a written letter of complaint with regard to an incident that took place December 15, 2013. The complainant had concerns with the length of time that it took EPS members to respond to the call. Upon review of the time line it was determined that EPS members responded on two occasions, in their first attempt EPS arrived in 104 minutes and could not locate the complainant who upon return call back indicated he had stepped into the washroom. The second attempt EPS members arrived in 34 minutes. Both response times were within the acceptable period of 120 minutes. As such the Chief concluded this matter on February 13, 2015.

Dear,

As February is anti-bully month, and 2015 is also significant for me personally, this is a quick note to express my sincere appreciation for the assistance and guidance that you gave me when I was trying to get out of an extremely difficult situation with my former spouse. I am sure that there are a lot of difficult days in your job, and that you do a lot of thankless work, I hope that this note will be read a few times, particularly on a day when you are feeling defeated. All four of you have had pivotal importance on my life at different times in the over ten years period of time it took me to escape the turmoil I had been living. Thank you. Two boys, who were 7 and 5 years of age when their life was turned upside down in the year 2000 with the deterioration of their parents' marriage, have now, I am proud to say, both graduated from High School, (deleted) graduated in 2012 and (deleted) graduated this past June. There certainly were days that I was unsure that tomorrow was going to come. Both boys are pursuing an apprenticeship and currently are in their first year of schooling.

(Deleted)...I will never, ever forget the day and circumstance we first met. My Dad and I were extremely weary after driving hundreds of miles to gather evidence, to try and get some assistance, and frustrated from getting jurisdictional run-around as we were trying to protect my safety and that of the boys. On that life-changing day that is etched in my memory I was quite despondent as I once again had to relay my situation to yet another person who was supposed to be in a position to help me. Unknown to me, you were an RCMP Officer. You hadn't even worked a day at the Provost Detachment yet. As I was

relaying my story and it was apparent that you (whom I thought was an “eavesdropping” construction worker in sweats lol-because the office was undergoing a reno) knew what had to be done to put me on track to getting life. I remember the relief that overcame me that finally I had someone on my side. Thank you. From that moment on, even though there were still many mountains to climb, I slowly inched my way to the freedom that I have today.

As part of the journey I was also very fortunate to have EPS Detective (deleted) introduced to me. (Deleted) I sincerely thank you for the comfort that you gave me during some of the darkest moments of my life. Your assertive, professional, empathetic and experienced manner will never be forgotten. Never underestimate the difference that you make in people’s lives. I felt so safe during those court appearances I had to make at QC in Edmonton. Your guidance and assistance as I was making my safe plan to return home was very helpful. At the time though, I am sure you had reservations as to how it was all going to turn out. I know that you had preferred me considering a move elsewhere with a new identity.

Though I haven’t spoken to you in some time, I know that I can still dial up the number that I still have on my person, and get some advice or assistance if I ever should need it.

Wainwright RCMP Detachment was where I met the very capable (deleted). This was after many breaches of the permanent restraining order that I had been given. Looking back, I remember how frightened I was to be taped during my interview as I provided evidence of the various events that had led up to our meeting. I was an extremely broken mess and I remember how you displayed concern and commented that I was suffering from battle fatigue which I did not fully comprehend at the time. It was so good to have someone who understood the dynamics of the situation and the peculiar circumstances associated with domestic violence. Thank you for the perseverance you invested on my behalf.

For a shorter period of time I had Cpl. (deleted) looking out for my best interests. Your involvement was at an extremely volatile time for me. The years of stress dealing with my life situation had been taking its toll; extreme anxiety and PTSD symptoms were a regular occurrence for me. The coordination that you had between Provost and Cpl. (deleted) was so very important. You clearly are well trained dealing with such difficult and emergent situations. I often reflect on how different my life might be had I not had such expertise going to bat for me.

Sometimes I can’t believe what all I have been able to overcome, I certainly never thought that I, someone who had gone to University and pursued a profession, would end up in a half-way house during my life journey. Nor did I ever think I would have been involved with law enforcement, let alone be in so many RCMP and Police detachments over the years. You have all touched my life profoundly. You do make a difference. I wanted to make sure that you knew that and hope that this letter brings a ray of sunshine to your day! Best wishes to you all!
