SUBJECT: Monetary Reward Renewal

It is recommended that a reward in the amount of \$40,000.00 be renewed for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for any of the 11 unsolved murders noted below. The victims are from the Canadian Central East African Community.

INTRODUCTION:

This report will provide basic information, present recommendations for action and update the EPC on rewards for the aforementioned unsolved homicides. Rewards are scheduled for renewal every three years.

1. **February 12, 2006** Edmonton Police Service were called to a shooting at #9, 10823-115 Street. **Omar/Mohamad ABDALLA** was found dead at the scene.

2. **May 15, 2007** Edmonton Police Service received a number of calls from the area of 133 Avenue and 82 Street of possible gunshots. Police responded and located a vehicle stopped in the alley at the rear of 13331-82 Street. One victim was located in the driver's seat. The second victim was found in the backyard of 13329-82 Street. Deceased: **Deng BULGAK and Juk RING**.
3. **September 02, 2007** Edmonton Police Service were called to Fulton Place Community Hall, located at 6115 – Fulton Road regarding gunshots at that location. Police found **Farhan HASSAN and Kasim MOHAMED** deceased at the location.
4. **September 16, 2008** Edmonton Police Service were called to 7055-132 Avenue after receiving a report of an injured adult male. **Nasir SAID** was found deceased at the scene.
5. **October 31, 2008** Edmonton Police Service were called to a report of a deceased male, who had been discovered by a passer-by in Northmount park, located at 9208-140 Avenue. **Abas ABUKAR** was deceased at the scene.
6. **December 02, 2008** Residents in the area of 109 Street and 130 Avenue heard several shots coming from Grand Trunk Park. Upon police arrival, a male identified as **Adbul MOHAMOUD** was found deceased.
7. **December 02, 2008** Edmonton Police Service received numerous calls of gunshots in the area of 148 Avenue and 90 Street. Upon police arrival in the area **Ahmed ABDIRAHAM** was found deceased.
8. **November 12, 2009** Edmonton Police Service were called to the Beth Israel Synagogue at 131 Wolf Willow Road, on a report of a male who was thought to be deceased. Police confirmed that **Abdulaziz ISSE** was deceased.
9. **November 29, 2009** Edmonton Police Service responded to reports of gunshots near 105 Street and 106 Avenue. **Rohleh MOHAMED** was found deceased at the rear of 10610-105 Street.

BACKGROUND:

In the eleven (11) unsolved homicide investigations very limited information has been brought forward by witnesses. The information has been very generic and limited to reports of gunshots and potential suspect vehicles leaving the area.

The Edmonton Police Service Homicide Section has engaged other police agencies across the country and the Central East African Community in hopes of solving these cases.

CONCLUSION:

The investigation into the loss of life, through the actions of others, is a priority of the Edmonton Police Service and that of Homicide Section. It is the opinion of Homicide Section that existing rewards for information that would lead to the arrest and conviction of persons responsible for any of these crimes be renewed.
